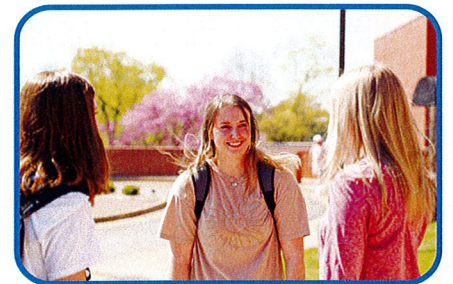

→ McAllaster Honors Scholar Requirements

Qualifications:

Freshman students with a 3.5 GPA or higher.

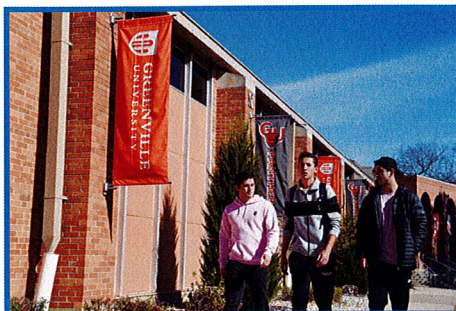
Requirements:

Submit an essay and be subject to an interview. Student must live on campus and participate in the scholarship group activities. Scholarship renewed annually if student remains in good standing with the institution.

Limit: 15 students

Program Requirements:

- Complete 21 hours of honors coursework. Honors courses are offered each semester and during Interterm. All honors courses meet general education requirements. Typically, McAllaster Scholars take honors course-load during their first two years and move toward more major-focused work during the Junior and Senior year.
- Write a Departmental Honors Project during the Senior year - a capstone research experience within your major discipline.
- You will select a research topic and assemble a faculty committee who will guide you in your research and writing. When completed, the project is presented and defended before the Departmental Honors Project committee.
- Maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or higher.

Qualifications:

Diverse freshman or transfer students with a 3.0 gpa.

Requirements:

Submit an essay and be subject to an interview. Student must live on campus and participate in the scholarship group activities. Scholarship renewed annually if student remains in good standing with the institution.
